Dress Code & Uniform Policy

Category: Student Affairs

1. Purpose

To promote a sense of belonging, equality, and professionalism among students through a consistent and appropriate dress code.

2. Student Uniform Requirements

Item	Requirement
School Uniform	Official school uniform must be worn every school day
Condition	Clean, pressed, properly fitted, and in good repair
Footwear	Clean, closed-toe shoes in approved school colors
Sports Uniform	Worn only on designated physical education(P.E) days
Outerwear	Jackets or sweaters must be in school colors
Hair	Natural colors; neat and tidy
Jewelry	Small stud earrings only; no large or distracting jewelry
Makeup	Not permitted for primary/middle school; minimal for high school

3. Uniform Exemptions

- Medical exemptions (e.g. footwear due to foot condition) must be supported by a medical certificate.
- Religious dress requirements are accommodated — parents must notify the school in advance.
- Special dress-down days are announced by the school.

4. Non-Compliance

- **First offense:** verbal reminder and contact with parents.
- **Second offense:** written warning sent home.
- **Continued non-compliance:** students may be asked to change before entering class or a meeting with parents is arranged.

5. Lost or Damaged Uniforms

- Replacement uniforms can be purchased from the school or approved vendor.
- A limited number of uniform items may be borrowed from the school office in genuine emergency situations.
